## Join us as we “Build A Better World” Summer Reading Challenge

### Reading Challenge GUIDELINES:

- The RPL summer goal is 16 hours which can easily be met by reading two hours each week for eight weeks; but of course, you may want to read more. See how quickly you can meet the 16-hour goal. For the eager readers, more hourly challenges are available. Example: first week, read 2 hours—meet first goal of 2 hours; next week read 2 hours—meet second goal of 4 hours. *Or you may read as many hours a week as you would like!!*
- Hourly goal increments: 2, 4, 6, 8, 10, 12, 14, 16.
- Reading logs and guidelines will be given when you register at first activity or during open library hours starting June 6 and throughout month of June.
- Record your reading times and the book titles, and a parent signs your log.
- Complete a goal and visit the Library to present your reading log to Library staff; receive your reward; and add a sticker for each hour read to your marker and move your marker to next goal completed.
- Each hourly goal has a designated reward which can be viewed on the Reading Rewards Display in the Library.
- All hours must be logged and incentive rewards claimed by 3 p.m. on Thursday, July 27.
- **All incentives/rewards available while supplies last.**
- *Children who complete the 16-hour challenge will receive a book and certificate.*
- Earn tickets for the Celebration Event drawings on July 29 each time you meet a reading goal and/or attend activities during June and July. Age group meeting dates on reverse side. Three prize drawings will be provided for each age group (preschool, elementary, teens). Must be present to win.
- You must sign the Activity Sign-In sheets in order to receive your ticket for participating that day.
