- Complete a goal and visit the Library to present your reading log to Library staff and receive your reward.
- Please add your children's hours on log before presenting to staff.
- Each hourly goal has a designated reward which can be viewed on the Reading Rewards Display in Library.
- All hours must be logged and incentive rewards claimed by 5 p.m. on Thursday, July 25.
- All incentives/rewards available while supplies last. Substitutions may be given.
- Children who complete the 16-hour challenge will receive a book and certificate.
- Earn tickets for the Celebration Event drawings on July 27 each time you meet a reading goal and/or attend activities during June and July.
